2003 Leonetti Cabernet Sauvignon - Bright medium ruby. Sexy sweet oak scents and a rose petal topnote complement cranberry, red cherry, cassis, mocha and coffee. Firmly built, fresh and sweet, with excellent intensity to the black cherry and mineral flavors. A very fresh and youthful cabernet that's still a bit youthfully tight. Finishes firmly tannic, with subtle oak tones and lovely grip. Will age well.

2005 Cayuse Syrah Cailloux Vineyard - Good bright dark red. Raspberry, pepper, woodsmoke, spices and dried herbs on the highly nuanced nose. Darker in its fruit character than the special Walla Walla bottling and less perfumed and expressive today in spite of its silky sweetness. Not especially creamy right now but boasts terrific lift toward the back and palate-staining length. Already delivers great appeal, but needs time to lose some of its baby fat.

2005 Domaine Drouhin Louise Pinot Noir - Deep red. Flamboyantly perfumed bouquet of black raspberry, cherry-cola, lavender and fresh rose. Smoky dark berry flavors are impressively concentrated but also vivacious and penetrating. Gains a sappy character on the long, powerful finish. More complex than the Laurene, with greater cling and sweetness. Strikes a compelling balance between strength and finesse.

2005 Chester Kidder Red Wine Columbia Valley - The 2005 Chester Kidder Red Wine is made by Gilles Nicault who is also the winemaker in residence at Long Shadows. It is a blend of 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Syrah, and 5% Merlot. It was aged for 30 months in 90% new, French and Hungarian oak. Opaque purple-colored, it reveals an alluring nose of brooding black fruit, pencil lead, mineral, and spice box. Round and ripe on the palate, it borders on opulence while concealing enough tannin to support another 6-8 years of cellaring. The sweet, savory fruit carries through into the lengthy finish. Drink this superb effort from 2013 to 2026.

2008 Cascade Cliffs Nebbiolo - Light rose color. Well-made, balanced, with classic licorice and bright fruit character. Full-bodied, with ripe texture, refined smooth tannins on the chewy long finish.

2005 Chateau malmaison 1.5 L - Very dark purple in color, showing aromas of mineral, dark chocolate and licorice. Full-bodied, with silky tannins and a fresh, clean finish. Layered and pretty. Very, very balanced. Close to the excellent 2000. Best after 2012.

2007 Lake Chelan Gewurtztraminer - Ripe grapefruit, ground almonds, muskmelon and NECCO wafer dust aromas lead into more grapefruit on the entry to the palate. Secondary flavors of juicy mango, apricots, Jolly Rancher green apple candy, a fair bit of residual sugar (1.6%), ample acidity and the lack of varietal bitterness make this quite quaffable.

2008 Lake Chelan Viognier - Light yellow-green straw color with hints of lemon, minerals, and tropical fruit. This Washington viognier offers a clean, crisp mouthfeel. Good minerality, bright acidity, and stonefruit flavors in this Lake Chelan wine.

2007 Delille Chaleur Estate Red - Full ruby-red. Claret-like nose offers raspberry, tobacco and spices. Broad, sweet, pliant and thick, conveying full ripeness and compelling concentration to its red fruit and coffee flavors. For all its sweetness, this dense wine boasts solid underlying structure for a slow evolution in bottle.

2008 Brian Carter Opulento 375 ml - Deep impenetrable garnet color. Aromas of raspberry, cherry and chocolate with hints of almond and baking spices. On the palate this wine has opulent flavors of chocolate and berry fruits with a perfectly balanced and satisfyingly sweet finish.

2007 Benson Syrah - 100% Syrah - Dark, rich and polished with a vibrant aromatic nose and elegant finish. This Syrah is full bodied and well balanced with a variety of hearty berries, black currants and smoky black pepper and fig flavors.
